Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to my letter No. 731-1-3/RC/94 dated 20th July 1994 inviting your comments on the proposal of K.L.N. Sourashtra College of Engg. Council, 69, South Veli Street, Madurai-625 001 for starting a new engineering college.

We have not received your any specific comments on this proposal. This proposal has been pending for consideration with AICTE for quite some time. Keeping in view a number of similar instances where the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, Tamil Nadu have passed orders to the AICTE for taking final decisions within specific time frame, the Council has therefore taken a final decision on this proposal now. The Council accordingly had set up an Expert Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. P.G. Reddy, Chairman, Southern Regional Committee which met on 10.8.1994. The committee considered the reports of the visiting committees in detail and also noted that the Director of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu was invited as a representative of the State Government in these committees. The Council had also invited him to attend the meeting of the committee held on 10.8.1994 and Dr. S. Vardarajan attended the same.

The Council has accepted the recommendations of the Committee and approves following courses for starting a new engineering college, "K.L.N. College of Engg., Konthagai Pottapalyam, Pasumponmuthuramalingam, Distt.-623 611" for academic year 1994-95.

It may be mentioned that the college will be allowed to make admissions for 1994-95 only after it obtains the affiliation from concerned University and observes the provisions of GSR 476(E) dated 20th May, 1994 as per the Gazette notification.

The above approval is subject to the fulfilment of specific conditions as under :-

1. The Management should complete the construction of buildings for running the first year and second year of the College at its proposed site before the commencement of the admission for the academic year 1995-96 and the College should start functioning at the permanent premises from the academic year 1995-96.
2. The students should be admitted to Mechanical Engg., Electrical & Electronics Engg., Electronics & Comm. Engg., only after obtaining the necessary affiliation from the concerned university.
3. Sanctioned strength of any branch should not be altered even by way of branch transfers without the prior approval of AICTE. The strength of any branch should not exceed 60.
4. If the State Govt. has a proposal for increase in intake during 1994-95 session for consideration of AICTE, the recommended intake considered in this report should be adjusted against the proposed increase in intake considering State as a unit.
5. The deficiencies pointed out by the Expert Committee should be rectified immediately and the Management should submit the Compliance Report for the same to AICTE.
6. An Expert Committee of AICTE will visit the College before the commencement of the admissions for academic year 1995-96 for review of infrastructural facilities created by the college.
7. The college should strictly follow any other conditions laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
8. The institute should also comply with the other conditions of AICTE as per annexure to this letter.

The approval is further subject to full compliance with the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its Judgement dated 4.2.1993 with regard to WP(C) No.607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan, UP and others etc. etc., Vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc., and later Judgements, and the related guidelines issued by the AICTE in this regard and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, or the Central Government from time to time.



General Condition

1. The Management including the Governing Body of the College shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
2. No new courses shall be started or an ongoing course shall be discontinued by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. The intake in any of the approved courses shall not be altered by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.
4. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, including Endowment fund, as prescribed by the AICTE.
5. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
6. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
7. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
8. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
9. Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
10. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc., shall be followed by the Institution.
11. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
12. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
13. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
14. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
15. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
16. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.
17. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
