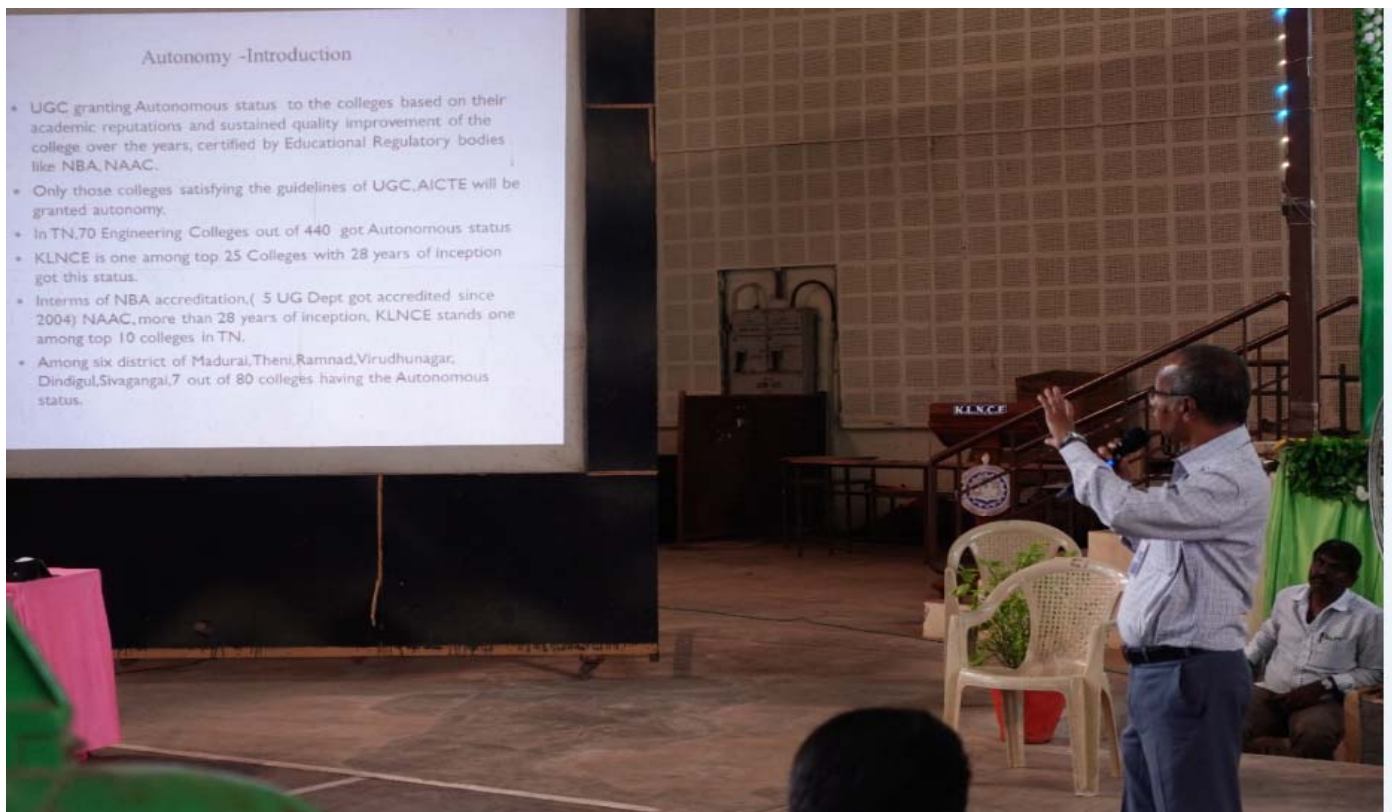
Address by Principal: Dr. A.V. Ramprasad – About History & Activities of KLNCE
